**Subject:** Ferndale Terrace Utility Relocation Work to Begin Next Week.

Good afternoon and happy New Year.

We have set up an email contact list for property owners, residents and others who may be interested in receiving updates for the Ferndale Terrace Project. If you'd prefer not to be contacted in future, please respond to this email and let us know to remove your address from our list.

As you may have already noticed, surveyors have been in the area placing survey stakes and markers along Ferndale Terrace and nearby adjoining streets. That survey work has been done on behalf of Puget Sound Energy (PSE). Starting next week, Asplundh crews will begin work to remove or trim vegetation that will conflict with PSE's work to relocate power lines along the roadway. Only the vegetation that will interfere with PSE's facilities will be impacted, and property owners should have already been notified by Asplundh and PSE directly. Other vegetation removal will occur when the City begins its project later this spring, estimated to begin in April. The City is currently soliciting bids from contractors who may be interested in rebuilding the roadway.

Puget Sound Energy crews are scheduled to begin their relocation work the week of January 13<sup>th</sup> when line crews and civil crews start work to place new poles, excavate for underground crossings, string new wire and begin transferring services to the new system. During both vegetation work and the utility relocation work, the roadway will remain open, and flaggers will be on site to direct traffic through the work areas. Please be patient and alert while workers are on site.
